## Need Help Developing Informed Consent Forms for DAIDS Supported and/or Sponsored Studies?

*Informed Consent Templates* are available on the DAIDS RSC Website to facilitate the development of these documents.



### What Informed Consent Templates are available on the DAIDS RSC Website?

DAIDS Protection of Participants, Evaluation and Policy (ProPEP) branch has developed two templates which can be used as guidelines or tools for informed consent development, and represent current best practices.

- **DAIDS Protocol Specific Informed Consent Template – General Use & Instructions Page** (*Version 1.0; Posted February 23, 2016*). This template addresses main study informed consent required elements as well as samples stored for batched testing required as part of the main research study.
- **DAIDS Sample Informed Consent Template – Stored Samples for Future Use & Instructions Page** (*Version 1.0; Posted February 23, 2016*). This template addresses the storage of unused (leftover) samples and the collection and storage of extra samples, along with the participants' associated health information, for future research.
