- The site organization will remain mostly unchanged. Information will still be grouped by target audience including Clinical Research Sites, Networks and Protocol Teams, and DAIDS Staff.
- The site will continue to provide quick access to resources and documents.
- The site will continue to be mobile accessible.

What will be new?

- The URL for the site will change.
- The style of the site will match the NIAID website.
- There will be some minor organization updates.
- The process for making website updates will change.

What does this mean for you?

- Any bookmarks for the DAIDS RSC Website will need to be updated.
- Any documents that reference the DAIDS RSC Website and include a link to the site will need to be updated.
- The DAIDS RSC should be contacted as early as possible when developing documents that will be posted to the site.
